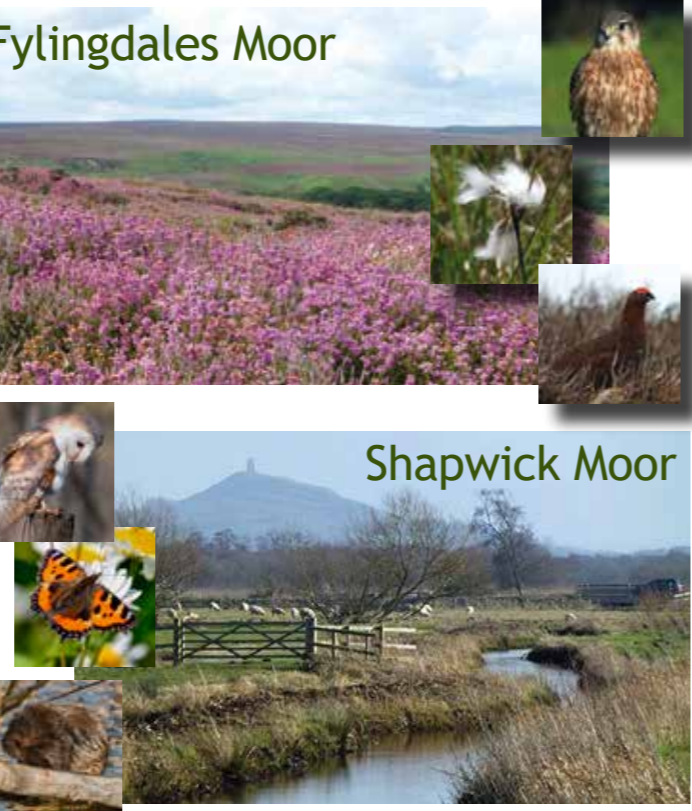

## and what your membership helps to support

*Sculthorpe Moor Nature Reserve* is located in the beautiful Wensum Valley, and is internationally recognised as important for its wildlife. It is a marvellous, peaceful place with a huge variety of wildlife in a rich and unusual mosaic of woodland, fen and reedbed habitats.

Boardwalks make access easy for everyone, guiding you through the reserve. Bird feeders and nest boxes are sited along the way and there are viewing platforms, places to sit and relax and a series of hides for watching wildlife, including the elevated Volunteer Hide and Aerial Walkway. All hides are fully accessible by wheelchair.

**April-October** (BST) 8.00am-5.00pm  
(Late-night opening Thursdays 8.00am-8.30pm, check for details)  
**November-March** (GMT) 8.00am-4.00pm

Last entry to reserve 1 hour before closing  
CLOSED Christmas Day, check for other times.

NO DOGS ALLOWED (except assistance dogs).

ENTRY A £5 donation is suggested from adult non-members. Children free.

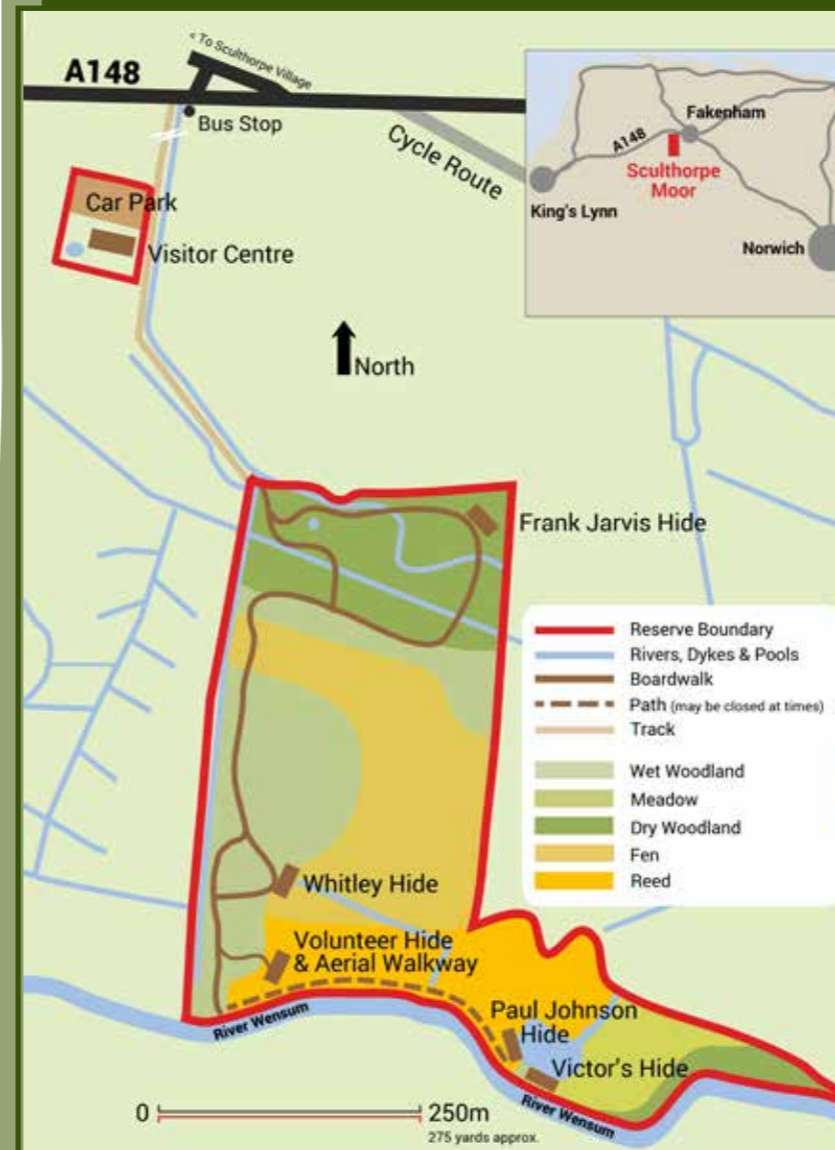
### What to look out for

**All year:** Tawny Owl, Barn Owl, Red Kite, Kingfisher (r), Buzzard, Bullfinch, Marsh Tit, Water Vole, Otter.



**Spring/summer:** Cuckoo, warblers, Marsh Harrier, Hobby, butterflies, dragonflies (l) and damselflies, Grass of Parnassus, orchids.

**Autumn/winter:** Redpoll (r), Siskin, Brambling, Water Rail, Bittern, Stoat in 'ermine', Scarlet Elf Cup and other fungi.



**HOW TO FIND US:** The reserve is a few miles inland from the North Norfolk coast, off the A148 King's Lynn to Fakenham road, just outside Fakenham town. Take Turf Moor Road (signposted 'Nature Reserve' on the A148) opposite Sculthorpe village. The Fakenham to King's Lynn bus stops at the end of Turf Moor Road. The car park and Visitor Centre are part way down the lane, disabled car parking is available at the reserve entrance next to the start of the boardwalk.
